AGENDA MAY BE AMENDED PRIOR TO BOARD MEETING

A meeting of the Essex County Board of Taxation was held on Thursday, March 21, 2013 at 9:20 a.m. at its office, 50 South Clinton Street, Suite 5200, East Orange, NJ.

1. ROLL CALL

Upon roll call, the following members were present: President Willis, Commissioners DeFuria, Johnson, Linares, Matarazzo, O'Brien and Administrator Durkin.

2. Approval of February 2013 minutes

President Willis requested a motion for the approval of the February 2013 Board minutes. Commissioner Johnson made the motion and was seconded by Commissioner Matarazzo. All were in favor and unanimously approved.

3. Adoption of the Preliminary Equalization Table

Administrator Durkin stated that three page 8 formulas have to be completed, East Orange, Glen Ridge and Newark. She is requesting a motion to approve Preliminary Equalization Table subject to complete review and approval by the auditor and State. Commissioner O'Brien made the motion to approve Preliminary Equalization Table after review. Commissioner DeFuria seconded the motion and all were in favor.

4. Approval of Overrides

Administrator Durkin stated that the City of Newark had over 1,000 overrides and they are finally complete. President Willis asked for a motion to approve the overrides. Commissioner Johnson made the motion to approve the overrides and was seconded by Commissioner Matarazzo. All were in favor.

5. Update of Deeds

Administrator Durkin stated that 600 more deeds have been processed at this time last year.

6. Update of Appeals / Hearing Schedules

Administrator Durkin stated that 1,700 appeals have been processed so far. Irvington has 611, West Orange 160, Bloomfield 140 and Montclair 124.

7. Status of 2014 Revaluation for Irvington and Orange

Irvington

Silvia Forbes, Tax Assessor stated that she hand delivered the contract to the State on March 7th. Tax map updates were completed and were submitted to the Local Property Branch on March 8th. Compliance report has been submitted for the Boards review. Discussion followed regarding the contract by Appraisal Systems. The Board had no comments or recommendations for the Director. A motion was made by Commissioner Matarazzo to approve the contract and was seconded by Commissioner Linares. All were in favor.

Commissioner Johnson recused himself from the meeting.

Orange

Representing the Township of Orange

Matt Rinaldi, Tax Assessor stated that the City of Orange Revaluation status has been submitted for the Boards review. On March 5, 2013 at a City Council Meeting a resolution authorizing Tyler Technologies to perform the revaluation was passed. Discussion followed regarding the period for the completion of the revaluation.

Commissioner Johnson returned to the meeting.

8. Municipal Reval Statistics

Administrator Durkin stated that an updated Status of Revaluation is in the Commissioner's folder for review.

9. Reminder: Appeal Deadlines - April 1st and May 1st

Administrator Durkin stated the deadline for appeals is for April 1 with four towns for May 1.

Sylvia Forbes, Irvington Tax Assessor stated that she and Commissioner O'Brien attended an interesting seminar on tax appeals. Chapter 123 was discussed and literature they received was shared.
